A short history on federal grants

Billions of dollars in

Federal grants are awarded each year for programs and projects that benefit the public. This assistance is rooted in the Constitution and it's a call to "promote the general welfare."

Federal grants started off as land grants and grants of the proceeds of land sales. A total of 130 Million acres

of federal land was then ceded as endowment for public schools and 4 million for higher education. By the Morrill Act of 1862, money and land was given to all states to build colleges. After the Morrill Act, there was the Hatch Act of 1887, Weeks Act of 1911, and federal aid road act of 1916. In 1918 grants were provided to combat venereal disease, in 1920 for vocational rehabilitation, and in

1921 for maternal and child health During the 1920's there were grants for transportation and communication .

Now grants span across different areas including social welfare, health, security, transportation, communication housing community facilities, labor, agriculture, veteran services and benefits, education, general research and general government.
