What is the IACUC?

The Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) is required by federal regulations for institutions that use animals in research and teaching. The IACUC is responsible for oversight and approval of animal activities and inspection of animal facilities. There are two sets of federal governing laws from which IACUC receives guidance. The Animal Welfare Act (AWA), which is overseen by the USDA, and the Health Research Extension Act (HREA) which is overseen by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The number one objective of the IACUC is to ensure that the highest, most humane animal welfare standards are met and maintained throughout all MSU research projects involving animals. This occurs through careful committee review of IACUC protocols, internal inspections of animal facilities, USDA inspections of animal facilities and animal practices, all with a structure set forth by the federal guidelines.
