Project Highlights

Garland Brett, Head of the Criminology Department and **Malega Ronald**, an Assistant Professor in the department of Geography Geology & Planning received **\$25,047** from the **Missouri State Highway Patrol** for the Domestic Violence Research Project. The project will descriptively analyze variables from 2000 to 2015 using ArcGIS technological capacity to create

numerous maps that overlays census tract characteristics with the domestic violence variables. Multi-level regression procedures will also be used to examine whether social disorganization measures such as the Neighborhood Quality Index and individual-level variables affect domestic violence across tracts.

Wiley Tammy, the General Manager of KSMU & Ozarks and **Knight Rachel**, the Assistant General Manager of KSMU & OPT received **\$759,872** from the **Corporation for Public Broadcasting** as a community grant to assist the Ozark Public Television with its annual operating cost.
