Responsible Conduct of Research

To promote research integrity, ethical conduct in research, and to comply with federal requirements, Missouri State encourages all student, staff, and faculty researchers to be trained in the Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR). With the passing of the CHIPS for America Act all NSF grant funded students, staff, and faculty are required to complete RCR training located in CITI. Covered individuals who fail to complete the required RCR training will be prohibited from further activities on the research project and will have research support revoked.
