ORCID Added to CITI Program

What is an ORCID iD?

It is a permanent numeric identifier that individuals own and control, which provides a way to distinguish themselves uniquely from other researchers and scholars. They are often used in systems and platforms from grant applications to manuscript submissions, and are increasingly required by funders, publishers, data repositories, and other research workflows.

What Does Adding ORCID Do?

CITI Program administrators can request to add the ORCID iD to their ad hoc reporting. This provides organizations with an additional way to confirm the identities of learners who complete CITI Program courses. For the data to become available you must link your ORCID iD to your CITI Program profile.
