CONFLICT OF INTEREST IN RESEARCH

A conflict of interest exists when significant financial interests or other personal considerations may compromise or appear to compromise professional judgment or integrity in the conduct or reporting of research or performance in administration, management, instruction and other university obligations.

The key to handling potential conflicts is to fully disclose significant financial interests and, if a conflict of interest is identified, to participate in the development and implementation of an appropriate management plan.

In the event the university discovers that a failure to comply with this policy has biased the design, conduct or reporting of the research the university will promptly notify the sponsor of the research as required by applicable law and describe the corrective action(s) taken or to be taken.
