EXPORT CONTROLS

The U.S. Government actively regulates, and in some cases, restricts the export of certain information, items and technologies deemed to be critical to the interests of national security, economy and/or foreign policy.

Questions to ask when traveling:

- Where are you going?
- What are you taking with you?
- What will you be doing and who will you be interacting with?

Items that require export control review include:

- Devices, systems, or software not available to the general public or designed or modified for military or space use
- Data or information received under confidentiality
- Data or analyses that result from a project with restrictions
- Classified information and export controlled information

Tools of the trade traveler certification letter is needed to take university property. University property must be effectively controlled by the traveler and cannot go to or through Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Syria, or Sudan.
